PCOL Report to Senate

23 June 2014

The Planning Council for Open Learning met on 23 June 2014, and approved the following:

NEW PROGRAMS:

1. MASTERS OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION (MBA)

Educational requirements:

To be admitted to the TRU MBA, students must complete the courses in the MBA Foundation (Graduate Certificate in Business Administration) with a grade of B (GPA 3.00) or higher or be exempted. (Note: all students must be eligible to be admitted into the Graduate Certificate in Business Administration).

Residency requirements:

Residency will be 50% of the MBA courses, i.e. 21 MBA credits for both the thesis and non-thesis route.

PLAR requirements:

PLAR cannot be used to satisfy residency requirements or thesis requirements.

2. MEDICAL LABORATORY ASSISTANT NATIONAL CERTIFICATE PROGRAM

Education Requirements:

Grade 12 or equivalent (GED acceptable) as required for MLA employment. Basic computer skills with typing at 40 words per minute on a 5-minute test as required by the approving body: BCSLS (BC society for Laboratory Science). Criminal Record Check, a pre-practicum and pre-employment requirement. Hepatitis B vaccination, a pre practicum and pre-employment requirement. Confirmation of a practicum training site. Certain admission requirements may be waived by permission of the Academic Director or designate.

Residency Requirements: 6 credits

PROGRAM REVISIONS

1. BACHELOR OF TECHNOLOGY
