Please review the following Conditions of Application:

A. This application form may only be used to apply for awards administered by TRU Student Awards & Financial Support (those listed in the online Awards Guide).

B. You are *automatically* considered for all applicable awards, scholarships and bursaries, **except for** Conditional Awards. Conditional Awards are ones where you need to provide additional information indicating why you meet the unique criteria. Conditional Awards are identified in the "Description" column of the Online Awards Guide. Most Conditional Awards require a short paragraph or essay - in the Conditional Award boxes at the bottom of this page, list the name of the award and clearly explain in the text box how/why you qualify.

C. A Bursary, Award, or Prize requires a minimum Undergraduate GPA of 2.00 in your most recent full-time semester and enrolment in at least nine Undergraduate credits (unless specific criteria state otherwise). Scholarships require a minimum Undergraduate GPA of 3.50 in your most recent full-time semester and enrolment in at least 12 Undergraduate credits in both the qualifying and receiving semesters.


D. A Bursary also requires demonstrated financial need using TRU's standardized assessment (modelled on government need assessment criteria), and is only for Canadian citizens or Permanent Residents.

E. Students may only apply once during the academic year. If exceptional circumstances arise which would warrant a second application, students may set up an appointment with a Student Awards Advisor. If your prior semester application has a status of "Eligible, No Offer", your application will automatically be carried forward and considered for funding again within the same academic year.






